Dear Pee Wee Parents,

This is the 10th annual Pee Wee Jamboree, in which we organize a big night, in a big stadium- for our smallest players. Parents, families and friends are encouraged to join us.

The festivities will begin at 6:00. All the teams line up on the stadium field and each Pee Wee player is introduced on the public address system and runs through the victory line. As the opening ceremony concludes, teams assemble on each sideline and are selected to play a round-robin tournament. We will run four games concurrently with time limits using the scoreboard clock. Our goal is to have each team play three games against different opponents.

We have made arrangements to use the reserved parking area inside the stadium, but parking is limited. PLEASE carpool if possible to maximize the reserved parking area. All vehicles and walk-ins may enter the stadium via the 8th Street gate. or the main gate at Seventh and Monument Streets.(See map)

The gates will be open at 5:30 and we encourage all teams to arrive between 5:30 and 5:45 to warm-up and organize. We ask a small fee for parking/admission. Adults are asked to donate \$1.00. Children, players and team coaches are admitted free of charge. We donate the proceeds to the LHS Academic Booster Club Scholarship program for allowing us to use the stadium.

NOTE: We ask that all parents and visitors remain off the field and track area. **Only players and coaches will be allowed on the track area or field.** We must have your cooperation in this regard. There is ample seating in the stadium and we ask all visitors to support their kids and teams in a positive manner. Inappropriate behavior and language will not be tolerated and violators will be asked to leave.

We organize this event so that these Pee Wee players have a fun and exciting night. We define success as ALL teams scoring a lot of touchdowns. We have set-up our game rules to help make that happen and we expect all coaches and parents to cooperate. Refreshments will be available in the stadium at a designated concession stand. Please join us for what is always a lot of fun and a very special night for our kids.
